

How to Make a Jade Ribbon

Directions:

1. Cut a three-inch length of ribbon, snipping both ends at an angle.
2. Lay the ribbon out horizontally with the shorter edge on top.
3. Hold down the ribbon's midpoint. Grasp the left end and fold so it points down and slightly across the midpoint. The fold can be a soft curve or a crisp line.
4. Fold the right end in the same way so the ribbon crosses itself about a half inch below the fold.
5. Where the ribbon crosses itself, use the small safety pin to hold the ribbon in place, concealing the pin behind the ribbon.
6. This same pin can be used to attach the ribbon to a collar or lapel.

Options: The ribbon can also be sewn together where it crosses by machine or by hand with a few stitches of thread. You can also use super strength glue to hold the ribbon together; then double stick tape or a safety pin can hold it to lapel.
