## How to Make a Jade Ribbon

## **Directions:**

- 1. Cut a three-inch length of ribbon, snipping both ends at an angle.
- 2. Lay the ribbon out horizontally with the shorter edge on top.
- 3. Hold down the ribbon's midpoint. Grasp the left end and fold so it points down and slightly across the midpoint. The fold can be a soft curve or a crisp line.
- 4. Fold the right end in the same way so the ribbon crosses itself about a half inch below the fold.
- 5. Where the ribbon crosses itself, use the small safety pin to hold the ribbon in place, concealing the pin behind the ribbon.
- 6. This same pin can be used to attach the ribbon to a collar or lapel.

**Options:** The ribbon can also be sewn together where it crosses by machine or by hand with a few stitches of thread. You can also use super strength glue to hold the ribbon together; then double stick tape or a safety pin can hold it to lapel.
